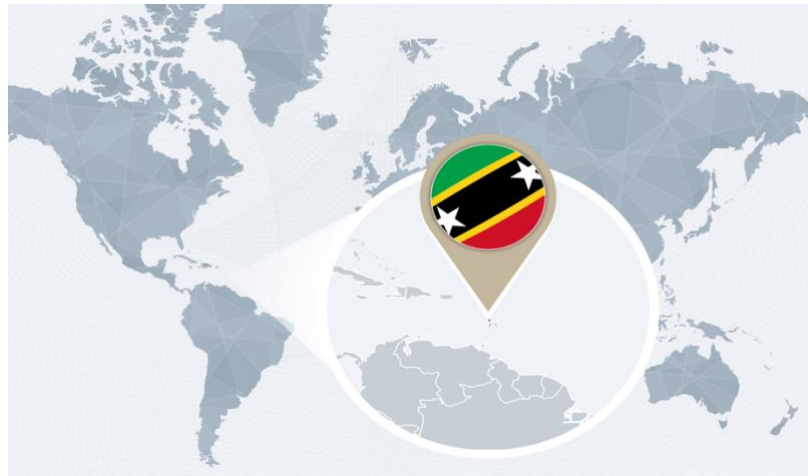

Investment Option

1-Real estate investment

Designated recoverable Real Estate Investment with a value of :

US\$ 325,000 held for seven years before resale

in addition of following government fees :

- **\$25,000 USD** for the main applicant
- **\$15,000 USD** for the spouse
- **\$10,000 USD** for each dependent under 18
- **\$15,000 USD** for each dependent above 18

2- Contribution to the Sustainable Island State (SISC)

A non-refundable contribution to SISC

The donated amount depends on the size of the family as follows:

- **\$US 250,000** for the main applicant or family up to 4
- **\$US 25,000** for each additional dependent under 18
- **\$US 50,000** for each additional dependent above 18

The following fees are added to all investment options:

Due Diligence Fees:

- **\$10,000 USD** – Main applicant
- **\$7,500 USD** – for each additional dependent aged 16 or older

Processing Fees:

- **\$500 USD** – Application fee (per applicant)
- **\$350 USD** – Passport issuance fee (per applicant)
- **\$500 USD** – Bank transfer fee for the main applicant
- **\$200 USD** – Bank transfer fee for each additional dependent



Procedures and Period

Initial Consultation

A free consultation where AVION CITIZENSHIP shows all the available options for the applicant and his/her family.

Signing the Contract & Payment of Fees

After signing the agreement, legal fees, government fees, due diligence fees, and application fees should be paid.

Documents Collection and File Submission

AVION CITIZENSHIP helps you obtain, translate and attest the necessary documents and prepare the file submission to the Citizenship By Investment Unit. It takes approximately 10 working days from the date of collecting all the needed documents.

Getting Approval

Upon getting the approval , applicant should pay all amount to get the Nationality Certificate

Obtaining the Passport

The process of issuing a passport take form 20-30 days from the date of obtaining the citizenship certificate

Note: All times are estimates and the actual execution time depends on the status

The Required Documents

Originals :

- 1- (HIV) test for the applicant, spouse and children over 12 years old
- 2- 12 month bank statement and reference letter from the bank
- 3-Proof of work letter (if the applicant an employee)
- 4-Certificate of no criminal record from each country has been residing in it for a period of one year or more over the past ten years for the main applicant, spouse and dependent children over 16 years of age
- 5- 8 passport size photos for main applicant , spouse & children

Copies :

- 1- A color copy of a valid passport for main applicant , spouse & children
- 2- A copy of birth certificate for main applicant , spouse & children
- 3- A copy of the marriage certificate
- 4- A copy of the divorce or custody documents (if any)
- 5- A copy of personal ID for main applicant , wife & children
- 6-A copy of academic certificate for main applicant, spouse, and children above 18 years (if any)
- 7- A copy of the commercial register or commercial company license & copy of memorandum of association (If the applicant owns a private business)
- 8- A copy of an electricity/water bill, a lease contract or a title deed shows full name and address
- 9- A copy of military documents (If any)
